**Blessed Assurance ([download program](#))**

Blessed Assurance is a 60-minute live show which delivers 1 John word-for-word in 5 acts along with original songs based on the story line.

In 5 short acts we deliver 1 John dramatically word for word along with a key question John would ask his hearers (e.g. Chapter 1 asks "Do you walk in the light as He is in the light?"). Our original songs like "Be Holy", "I Run", and "When you Turn" are based on the Scripture text. They underscore the theological and behavioral calls in this wonderful letter.

If you struggle with assurance of your salvation, come and be encouraged. John wants true believers to walk confidently in their God given faith.
